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Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Leslie High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2023-24 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given a label as "targeted," "additional targeted," or "comprehensive support and improvement."

After analyzing the Annual Education Report, we are continuing to reinforce our tier II interventions at the high school. We are also continuing to strengthen our tier I instruction.

State law requires that we also report additional information:

- Students are assigned to Leslie High School primarily by
 - residence/district boundaries. Out of District School of Choice
 - students also attend Leslie High School by application.

- Leslie High School has created a Michigan Integrated Continuous Improvement Plan. This plan is aligned with our district improvement goals and is reviewed and updated annually.

- Leslie High School does not have any “specialized schools.”
- At Leslie High School, the core curriculum is aligned with the Michigan Merit Curriculum. The curriculum framework does not vary from the State’s model. - Aggregate achievement results for local competency tests and
 - nationally normed achievement tests are available by contacting Leslie High School (517) 589-9500.
- During the 2022-23 school year, 24% of our students were represented by parents at parent teacher conferences. At Leslie High School, we continue to offer opportunities for scheduled parent/teacher conferences three times per school year. Additionally, teachers are available to conference with parents at any time throughout the school year if needed.

 - THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS RECEIVING A SCORE LEADING TO COLLEGE 2018-19 2019-20 (20, 5%), 2020-21 (16, 5%), 2021-22 (7, 2%), 2022-23 (13, 4%)
