BOARD DISCUSSION AND/OR ACTION

A. Sinking Fund

Superintendent Powers and Dave Medcoff shared a Sinking Fund update with the board. The board discussed potential sinking fund projects and a projected course of action through June of 2022. One potential item discussed was a new 6-lane track. Dave will get bids for a new 6-lane track and update the board at a later meeting.

B. ESSER III

Superintendent Powers shared the new requirements of the ESSER III grant compared to ESSER I and II. Stakeholder involvement is a requirement of the ESSER III grant. LPS sent a survey on potential needs to all parents and staff. Superintendent Powers will update the board on the grant at a later meeting.

C. Land

Superintendent Powers shared the request of a community member to purchase a parcel of land the district owns off Main Street. The board discussed the possibility of selling the parcel of land. Superintendent Powers will contact a realtor to determine fair market value and update the board at a later meeting.

D. MIOSHA

Superintendent Powers updated the board on the current Emergency Temporary Standard issued OSHA, requiring employers with 100 or more employees to enforce a mandatory vaccination policy. Currently the OSHA mandate has been blocked in the legislature and MIOSHA has not moved forward with implementing the mandate in Michigan yet. Superintendent Powers shared with the board that LPS has a plan ready should the mandate be enforced and will update the board at a later meeting.
