##### Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

**Woodworth Elementary (PreK - 4):** At Woodworth Elementary we have continued to offer a hybrid of in-person and online learning options for all students. In-person instruction is provided 4 days each week, with 1 day of distance/remote learning. Online instruction is provided 5 days each week for our virtual learners. During the week of March 26 - April 1, 2021, all students transitioned to virtual learning due to a recent spike in positive cases within the district.

**Leslie Middle School (5 - 8):** At LMS we have continued to offer a hybrid of in-person and online learning options for all students. In-person instruction is provided 4 days each week, with 1 day of distance/remote learning. Online instruction is provided 5 days each week for our virtual learners. During the week of March 26 - April 1, 2021, all students transitioned to virtual learning due to a recent spike in positive cases within the district.

**Leslie High School (9 - 12):** At LHS we have continued to offer a hybrid of in-person and online learning options for all students. In-person instruction is provided 4 days each week, with 1 day of distance/remote learning. Online instruction is provided 5 days each week for our virtual learners. During the week of March 26 - April 1, 2021, all students transitioned to virtual learning due to a recent spike in positive cases within the district.

##### Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

Additional support is available on distance learning days for students to work individually or in small groups with teachers/staff at each building. Additional support is available any school day through our teachers/staff, at-risk students and special education can come into school for an arranged time to work with their teachers and/or instructional aides.
